SURFACE OWNER NOTIFICATION

Please note that this surface owner notification is being submitted in accordance with Chapter 2830 of the Forest Service Manual, the law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and the decision of the United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania in the matter of United States of America v. Minard Run Oil Company, Civil Action No. 80-129 Erie.

East Resources, Inc. (ERI) is planning development activity of its outstanding oil and gas property rights which will include disturbance of the surface. The development activity is planned to occur at locations where the Allegheny National Forest (ANF) enjoys co-ownership of the property. For planning purposes and the commitment of both financial and physical resources our activity is scheduled to proceed or to be able to proceed no later than the 61st day following your receipt of this notification. For all purposes the date of receipt will be the date that a postal delivery service reports delivery of the notification at the Allegheny National Forest Office mailing address. Please be advised that we are extending to you the prescribed, long-established, and customary 60 day period within which your accommodation requests and any matters incidental thereto should be resolved.

In the event that you have requests, concerns, questions, or objections to any aspect of the attached plan of operations you are obligated to promptly contact the field representative designated in the attached plan. In all events, any such concerns, questions, or objections must be expeditiously communicated to ERI so that the 60-day time period for concluding accommodation matters is not exceeded.

Failure to complete your processing of this notification reasonably or expeditiously and, in all cases, after the passage of 60 days will be considered a denial of and interference with ERI's right to access and develop its private property rights.

East Resources Inc. plans to drill additional wells on Warrant 5573 West. We plan to drill up to 11 wells in two different areas. These wells will be built and drilled in coordination with work we are currently doing in the area. East Resources Inc. plans to start work by early mid summer of 2008 contingent on the Allegheny National Forest Service approval. Work will continue through the end of the year. The wells will be tied into existing tank batteries. Pipelines will be buried and will follow roads when ever practical. These wells will have pump jacks. The wells will use electric off the existing system. Electric lines will be buried. Gas will be transported through a 2" plastic pipeline that will be connected to our existing gas line system.
