1. Phone Conversation with Bob Gleeson Manager of DEP Meadville Oil and Gas Division.
2. I discussed the need for a survey on this piece of property.
3. I discussed other Oil Companies who have or are going to pay for Archaeological Survey (Phase 1).
4. Bob stated Four Rivers Lawyer was asking questions on the laws of all this.
5. I told him that the antiquities act of 1906, the Historic Sites Act of 1935 the Preservation act of 1966 amended 2001, NEPA 1979 and State laws on cultural resources applied.
6. We discussed SHPO and their Role in the State and the fact that SHPO would ask for this survey to be conducted when he asked for "Hits" under their permitting system.
7. I told Bob that I have been in contact with SHPO on this and other OGM Projects. I gave him Steve McDougal's phone number at SHPO. He was going to call him as well.
8. I let him know that SHPO had hits on a recent PAPCO project and we were working together to get PAPCO to do the survey.
9. I gave him examples of past and present- where surveys were conducted.
10. I let Bob know that the Four Rivers project is just on a sensitive piece of ground.
11. I also let him know that we would certainly work to negotiate with Four Rivers the best survey interval. But the reality is it needs surveyed. I also stated that the survey needed was all on their impact. That I would design the survey differently if I could but really he is responsible for his impact area.
12. We discussed the fact that other oil companies are paying because they are on a tight schedule for drilling and fracturing. Time is money.
13. We discussed THPO wanted this surveyed at 5 meter interval, the SHPO required intervals of 15 meter but new guidelines soon coming out were going to be 5-15.
14. I let him know that we the ANF were splitting the difference at 10 meter intervals for roughly 9000 feet of line. We would negotiate in good faith to 15 meter if necessary.
15. We discussed THPO viewpoint on visuals on Sacred Sites. THPO concerned that this scarring of the landscape could be seen from a nearby sacred site. I still need to verify these visuals.

Conclusions: Bob Gleeson was going to call SHPO to discuss this with Steve McDougal. He seemed to be on the same page as me for the need and the laws.
