Subject Gas Leak along FR148 on Duhring's Lease

Good evening Tony,

I am writing to inform you that Al Wetzel informed me that Steve Dyne, road contractor working on the Rock Run timber sale road package, hit a gas line along FR 148 which created a leak. Duhring Resource Company has the lease in this area. Jeff Stevenson and Len Jedrek met with Art Stewart and Steve Tachoir, both of Duhring, about the proposed work. Duhring informed the Forest Service that it did not know exactly where many of lines were on the lease because Azco/Shaboom did not provide maps to Duhring that illustrated the existing lines (please refer to the e-mail Len wrote regarding the field visit). At this meeting, they developed the course of actions that should be taken if a line was hit. After Al and I spoke on the radio, Darryl John, Civil Engineering Technician, informed Al that Steve Dyne (or a representative of his company) was going to put a clamp on the line and he will contact a Duhring field representative. This is the plan Len, Jeff, Steve Dyne and Duhring agreed to during their field visit. Since I was aware of the situation, I called Art Stewart directly to make him aware of gas leak. He thanked me for the information, and he said he was going to contact a Duhring field representative to get an update. If you need additional information, please let me know.
