also when marking ogm it probably is best to 100% tree tally unless its a very big package where sampling is prudent. will take some more time but accuracy will hopefully be better

also when cruising any timber whether ogm or regular sale be sure anyone cruising timber is certified or is ok'd by jim campbell to be out there marking. remember you are the senior cruiser for the forest any marking done under your guidance or presence on a marking crew that day you will be held responsible for cruising that sale.
