Subject Status of Lot 8 Deck Sale (New Shawmut Tbr Corp)

Tony -

I talked earlier today with Dave Cotterman regarding the status of the Lot 8 deck sale and New Shawmut Timber Company. I wasn't able to catch you after the training.

Here is my understanding of the present status, according to Dave:

1. Ed Kocjancic of New Shawmut has talked with Mr. Stewart to discuss Mr. Stewart's concerns and New Shawmut's responsibilities in view of those concerns.
2. To the best of my knowledge, a good portion of the access road has been stoned by Stewart (Duhring) and New Shawmut may use that segment to truck decked products out.
3. The rest of the access road on this sale, New Shawmut will have to utilize a forwarder to remove the timber per the contract.
4. New Shawmut wasn't planning to start any operations this week in view of the recent wet weather, to avoid any possible damage to Duhring's road.
5. New Shawmut has also taken photographs of the road condition in order to establish its pre-haul condition.
