Subject Duhring Resources FR 148

The following is a summary of events that took place in regards with the unknown pipeline installation by Duhring resources.

On 9-28-07 it was brought to my attention by Len Jedrek that someone excavated out and installed what looked like a pipeline across FR 148 within approximately 150 feet from the intersection of SR 948. The concerns are that damage has occurred to FR148, settling of the backfill material, plus the investment of DSA surfacing on this road which had not been restored. It didn't appear that any compaction of the backfill material had taken place which in turn was resulting in settlement of the road surface. This road as we all know is a highly used road not only by oil and gas but by the public as well.

After discussing the situation with Len I assumed this had been done by Duhring Resources being they have new development happening on both sides of the road at this location. On Thursday October 4th I talked with Arthur Stewart on this earth disturbance across FR 148 and he verified that it was for the installation of a pipeline. I mentioned to him that he needs to have this approved prior to work being done. I also informed him that there was damage to government property and law enforcement would probably get involved. He responded that if we were taking legal action that he had nothing further to say.
