
I write in follow up to my letter of November 1, 2007. I have not yet received the letter which I understand Mr. Fallon is sending to Duhring.

However, I did speak with both John Thomas and Tony Opredek, of the DEP. Both are waiting to see a copy of Mr. Fallon's letter, and when I have that letter in hand, I will be meeting with Mr. Opredek to discuss options for proceeding under the Consent Order and Agreement between Duhring and the DEP. Please recall that the Consent Order and Agreement contains obligations which Duhring must meet by December 19; therefore, I need for Mr. Fallon to send his letter at the earliest possible time.

With respect to that letter, and in particular with respect to the options Mr. Fallon will be covering for stone, I want to address a rumor I heard. I was informed that East Resources recently conducted extensive tests at the FR 403 pit, under Forest Service supervision, and that the tests revealed that the 5,000 cubic yards of stone was not actually present. In fact, it was rumored that no usable stone, at all, was found. If there is any truth to that rumor, I would appreciate being provided an update in Mr. Fallon's letter, since that information, if true, would obviously have significant impact on the options that the Forest Service is holding out to Duhring.

I am writing this letter to you since Mr. Fallon designated you as the contact person. However, since this letter addresses matters which will be issuing from Mr. Fallon's desk, I am sending him a copy as well, by first-class mail.

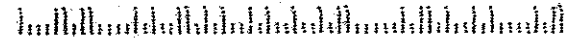

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
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
