I drove back FR387 (Scott Farm) and found a small dozer parked at the end. There was a new road that was getting used frequently leading from there back into the woods. I walked this new road, which was built across the native ground, for approx. 3/8's of a mile and did not come to the end. I turned around at that point since I did not have my gps. This new road does cross a small stream, where they laid mats down over the crossing. I also noticed several pulp trees pushed over and the root structure of many cut. I do believe it is Duhring plugging a well back there since the dozer looks like it belongs to S&T Supply. I will do a more thorough evaluation on Monday. I did see DEP coming out of FR387 onto SR66 this week, but did not think anything about it.

I asked Hunter if this road was included in the RUP's we developed months ago and he was going to look into it. All in all, the FS did not know anything about this project.
