Subject Duhring case

Rob,
On August 10th, Paul Weese, Mike Lewis and I stopped by the camp to see if we could find our boundry markers.
At a later date Ralph Bowmaster did survey the area to stake our boundry.
On August 20th John Thomas from DEP answered my questions about crossing property boundries.
This email was sent August 20th, 2007 from me to Rob Fallon, Paul Weese, Lauren Miles and Mike Lewis.

I just talked to John Thomas from DEP. He said that he does not know of any legal notification to cross a landowners property to access a lease. He said that the landowner is notified if a well is drilled within 1000ft. John also said that Duhring is under a time constraint, they have 1 year from the time Duhring purchased the lease to plug the wells which had been identified by DEP.
