Subject Warrant 3672

I have drafted a letter to Mr. Stewart summarizing the actions and the current situation regarding the timber removal on Warrant 3672. I have set Jim, Tony, Randy and Leanne as reviewers in the CDB and would appreciate it if you can do so. A copy is included here.

To clarify, for Shetler to continue their operations on Warrant 3672:

1. They will agree in writing to the conditions listed in the draft letter (Randy Durner will draft a second letter to Shetler, proposing the conditions, with a requested reply). This includes agreeing to possible repair of damages resulting from Duhring's pipeline installation. Randy will copy Duhring with Shetler's agreement to the conditions.
2. Duhring will acknowledge the conditions listed in the draft letter (to Rob).
3. Prior to any operations, the purchaser, TSA and Mr. Stewart will agree, and I will confirm in writing to Duhring, that the conditions are appropriate for the resumption of timber removal.
4. Dave Cotterman will inspect this project on a daily basis when Shetler is on site, he will document all operations and damages, and he will discontinue operations if evidence of thaw or damage occurs ... this includes refraining from the temptation to get one more load out when conditions are deteriorating.

I would like to have this resolved by December 2, and have everyone involved clear and in agreement on the conditions under which the timber on Warrant 3672 will be removed.
