I write to inquire as to when you think the Forest Service might be removing its timber from the captioned parcel. As you know, some of that timber is stored on well locations which Duhring intends to drill. The timber obstructs those proposed drilling operations, and if I had a timetable for the timber removal, Duhring would be able to schedule the drilling rig.

On a semi-related matter, I note that last weekend's wind storm (the Hurricane Ike remnants) blew down some timber across the newly made roads. Some of that timber might have marketable value, and perhaps you might like to add it to the sale. At the very least, please let us know whether you will be removing the blowdown from the road or whether we should simply cut it up in order to gain passage.
