I received communication from Duhring Resources on Friday afternoon (3pm fax). The letter raised two questions: 1) Request for timetable for removal of decked timber; and 2) Our plans for removal of blowdown timber on the access road. We are working on the first, and can provide a timetable when Oak has finished with his reappraisal. I will discuss with Tony how best to communicate our intentions to Duhring. With regard to the second, Oak and I noted 3-4 tress across the first sections of Duhring's main access road. We did not inspect further up the hill. Mr. Stewart id suggest that we "might like to add it to the sale"; and that we, "at the very least, please let (Duhring) know whether (we) will be removing the blowdown from the road or whether (Duhring) should simply cut it up in order to gain passage." Oak, please advise on Monday how you would like to address this second issue. I would like to respond verbally to Mr. Stewart on Monday afternoon. Rob.
